## **Introduction**

Cheshire West and Chester Council wants all children and young people with Special Educational Needs (SEN) to have access to a range of provision and support across the borough that will meet their educational needs and provide good opportunities for children to make progress.

We recognise that children and young people are not all the same and that some require additional support in order for them to fulfil their potential.

Wherever possible, pupils should have their needs met in a mainstream school. All schools, in all circumstances, should, therefore deliver a broad and balanced curriculum to all pupils, differentiated according to individual need.

A small number of children and young people may need a very high level of specialist teaching and support. Schools with a resourced provision and special schools will play a significant role in meeting the needs of this small group of children and young people

## **Mainstream Schools with Resourced Provision**

Schools with resourced provision provide skilled teaching and specialist support for small group work, withdrawal support and the implementation of a curriculum highly personalised to need which includes access to mainstream class teaching. Pupils attending mainstream resourced provision are included in large class and whole school activities where appropriate.

Places at mainstream resourced provision are commissioned by the Local Authority following an individual assessment of the pupil and agreement with parents and the school.

## **Special Schools**

Special schools provide skilled teaching and specialist support in small classes. School staff are highly skilled in meeting the needs of children with a range of more complex special educational needs. The curriculum and environment are designed to meet the needs of the pupils and individual plans are in place and progress closely monitored

## Resourced Provision in Mainstream Schools for pupils with Complex Learning Difficulties (CMLD)

There are five mainstream primary schools across the borough with resourced provision for primary aged pupils with complex learning difficulties. These schools are specially funded to provide the additional provision for a small group of pupils who need a greater level of support than available in a mainstream school. The resourced provision have staff with skills and knowledge in meeting the needs of children with CMLD and associated difficulties and provide personalised programmes to include small group and/or individual teaching as well as supported time in mainstream classes and activities. It is likely that the majority of pupils attending this type of provision in upper key stage 2 would transfer to specialist provision for secondary education.

## Resourced Provision in Mainstream Schools for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Condition/Aspergers

There are two primary and two secondary schools with resourced provision for pupils with autism. These schools are specifically funded to provide the additional provision for a small group of pupils who need a greater level of support than available in a mainstream school. They may need a sensory environment that meets their learning needs and access to speech and language therapy input. The resourced provision have staff with skills and knowledge in meeting the needs of children with autism and provide personalised programmes to include small group and/or individual teaching as well as supported time in mainstream classes and activities as appropriate. Pupils transferring into Key stage 3 (secondary) may move into mainstream schools, secondary resourced provisions or special schools depending upon the level and type of interventions they need.

## **Resourced Provision in Mainstream School for Social Emotional and Mental Health Difficulties**

There are two provisions to meet the needs of primary aged pupils with SEMD. These schools are specially funded to provide the additional provision for a small group of pupils who need a greater level of support than is available in a mainstream school. The resourced provision have staff with skills and knowledge in meeting the needs of children with SEMD and provide personalised behaviour management programmes to include small group and/or individual teaching as well as supported time in mainstream classes and activities as appropriate. Pupils who will require specialist provision for secondary education are likely to transfer to one of our two special schools who are also registered to take pupils from year 5.
