Ealing Council is consulting on its draft children's centres strategy for the next three years (2019-2022), which means there may be changes to how children's centre services are provided in the future. We currently have 27 children's centre sites in the borough - 7 main centres and 20 linked sites. The future proposal is to retain the 7 main children's centres but out of the 20 linked sites some services may be re-organised or reduced at 11 sites.

The consultation is open from 22 February until 17 May 2019, and this survey asks for your opinion on the proposed changes and how they might impact you.
