Our Data Analyst Apprenticeship Pathway consists of a two year opportunity to build on your problem solving and analytical skills whilst working towards a Data Analyst Level 4 qualification. This apprenticeship pathway would suit those who have an interest in Computer Science or Maths. Data analysts work on information management. They collect and cleanse data and can conduct a range of analytical studies on that data. They report the results of data analysis activities which helps the teams they work in make changes to improve the services that Islington residents use.

There are 2 roles available and following the initial application process, the successful applicant will join either Islington Council's People's Directorate or Public Health Directorate.
