Group Information

Baby Group: Friendly stay & play groups for parents and carers with babies aged up to 12 months. Come along to meet other new parents! (Ages 0-1)

Stay & Plays: Friendly groups with structured activities to support your child's learning in preparation for nursery and school (Ages 0-5).

Rhyme Times (Libraries): Musical fun to support your child's speech, language and communication skills. Come along and join in! (Ages 0-5). Sessions marked with * are sometimes run by library volunteers.

Friday Club: Cooking, Arts & Crafts, Football, Games, Table Tennis, Music, Film Making, Photography, Debates. (Ages 11-16)

Revolutions Youth Club: Cooking, Arts & Crafts, Football, Drama, Music, Pool, Table Tennis (Ages 11-24 with SEND).

Duke of Edinburgh's Award: A chance for Young People to complete either their Bronze, Silver or Gold Award (Ages 14-19).

Senior Chill Night: Cooking, Arts & Crafts, Sports, Pool, Games, Film Making, Photography, Music, Debates (Ages 15-19).

Other Services for Parents / Carers

Introducing Solids: An informal session with health visitors offering advice and good practice around weaning (Spring House 1st Wednesday of the month, Edenbridge 2nd Wednesday of the month).

Development Checks: 1 and 2 year development checks held by Health Visiting Team. Appointment Only.

Baby Hub: Drop in clinics led by the Health Visiting Team, for advice on child health, weight and nutrition. To speak to your local Health Visiting Team on 01732 470345.

Breast Feeding drop-ins with Peer Support : These are social drop-in groups run by the health visiting team. All pregnant and breastfeeding women and their families are welcome to attend to meet other local families and make new friends. Peer supporters present at all groups.

Parenting Courses: The 0-25 Early Help Service offers a range of courses to support parenting, including Solihull and Cygnets (for children with ASD diagnosis). Please ask at your local centre for more information.

Volunteering and Family Learning Courses: For parents interested in developing their skills, or who are looking for experience to help them enter employment.

Solihull Parenting Programme Health Visitors and Early Help Workers deliver this 'first response' to parenting for families who may benefit from early intervention in order to prevent development of future difficulties in children aged 0 - 7 years.

Healthy Child Clinics: Drop in clinic to get advise and weigh your baby. Run by the health visiting team.
