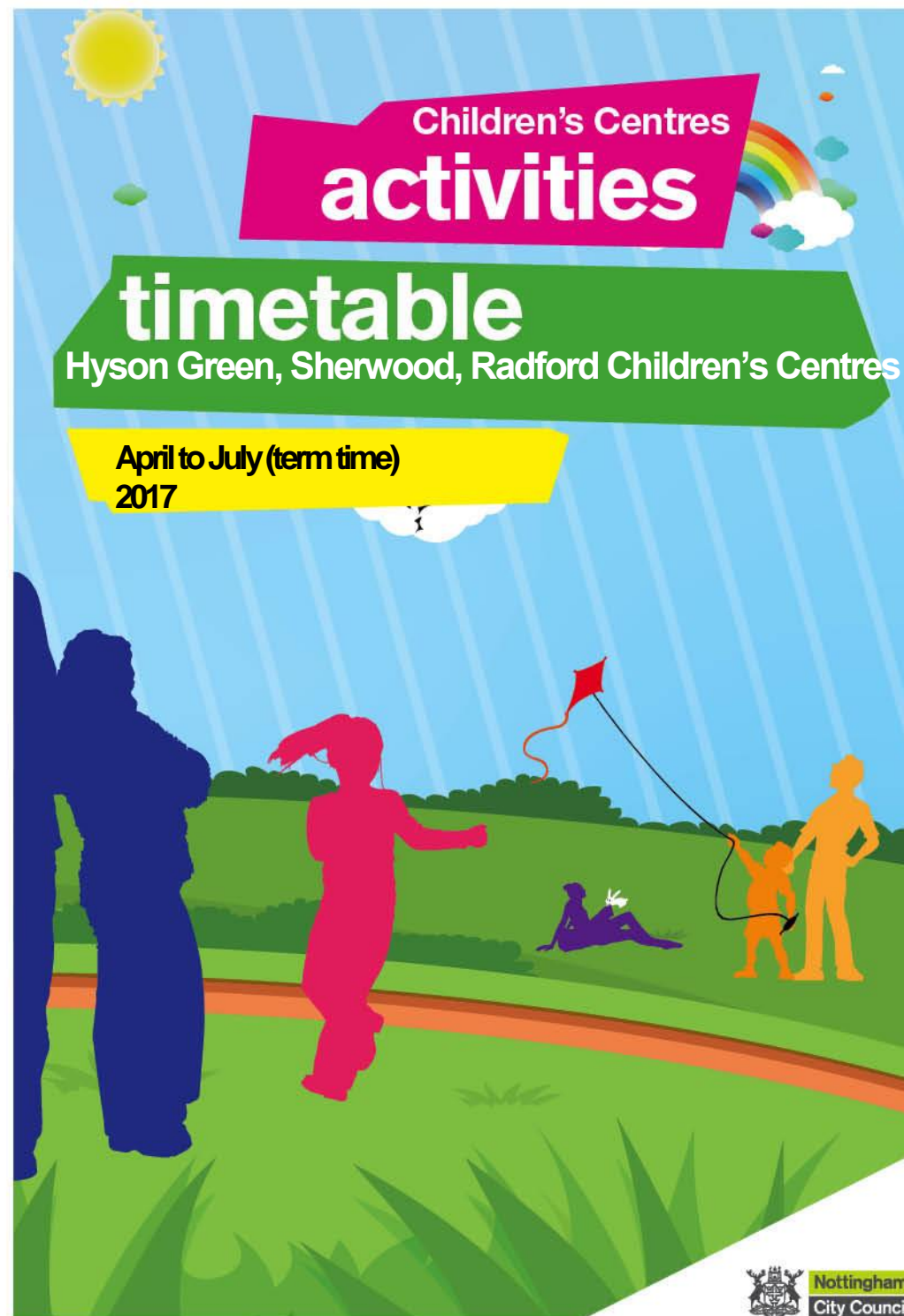

Children's Centre Activities

Children Centres provide a variety of sessions and support for families from pregnancy to 5 to support this. All families are welcome. To keep you up to date with all of the sessions and support we offer, we will request that you complete a Children Centre Registration Form. For more information please ask a staff member who will be happy to help. All sessions unless stated otherwise are FREE!

Sessions' Descriptions	
Family Support Clinic	One stop shop for early help support or referral to other agencies for families with children 0-19. This may include DV support, behaviour, benefit support, food vouchers, housing support, school admissions support / setting applications.
Stay, Play & Learn	Come and join us, as we play & sing together; encouraging learning and development through play with a wide range of activities and resources available.
Volunteer Programme	6 week workshop to provide adults with the learning and understanding to enable them to carry out volunteer work. Crèche available.
Sing & Wiggle with Rainbow Stripes	A fun interactive singing and music session for children 0 – 5 years. (Cost: £1 per child)
PEEP Watch Me Grow ; Inbetweenies ; Getting Ready for Nursery	12 week programme especially for you and your baby. Learn about child development, gain new parenting skills, make new friends and have fun together.

Free Childcare for 2 Year Olds

The Early Learning Programme (ELP) for 2 Year Olds is a Government initiative that provides free childcare places for eligible 2 year olds. Eligible children will be entitled up to 15 hours per week of free early education for a total of 38 weeks. Free places are available in participating childcare providers across the city.
