



Safe Place Scheme



The Safe Place Scheme aims to help people who have a learning disability feel safe when they are out in the community such as going to the shops.



It does this by putting a 'Safe Place' sticker in the window of shops and businesses. When you see the sticker you know they are a safe place for you to go if you have an emergency.



If you were shopping in town and you were scared because you were being followed by someone, being bullied or you had something stolen, you could walk into a shop with the 'Safe Place' sticker in the window.



If you went into the shop you would show them your 'Safe Place' card and they would call your carer or support worker for you so they could come and help.
