The Buzz Network forms our Local Authority Disability Register and will be kept in accordance with our privacy policy.

By completing this form you understand that Southampton City Council will hold your information for the purpose of forming the SCC Disability Register and that SCC may share your information with other organisations or departments, however, it will only do so when it is necessary in order for the service to be provided. In performing this service, the Council may be required to share your information with different agencies — to ensure that you receive the most appropriate and efficient service; for instance professionals in the local authority and our commissioned Short Break Providers — however, it will only do so when it is necessary in order for the service to be provided. The Council may also share personal information for the purposes of the prevention, investigation, detection, or prosecution of criminal offences, but will not share personal information, or use it for this, or any other purpose, unless provided for by law.
