Action for Children, working alongside other fantastic organisations, runs a programme of fun, educational and therapeutic activities for disabled children in Stoke-on-Trent.

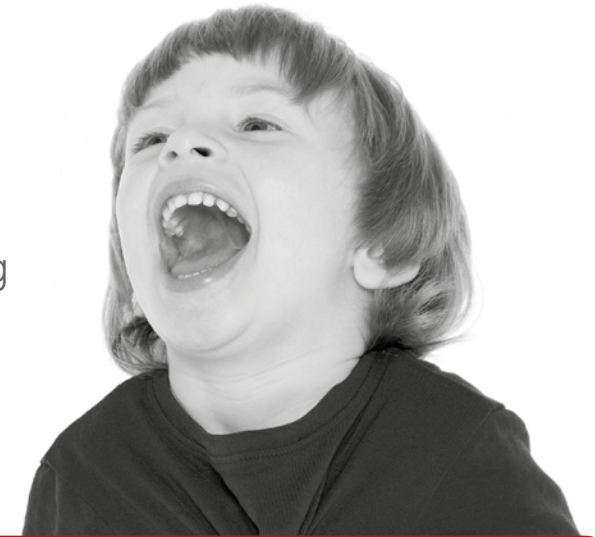

Children from 0-19 years-old are able to come to One free activity per month, plus additional activities over holiday periods and there's more on offer should you wish to pay for more. We also encourage all families to take part.
