Established in 1964, the club offers a wide range of sport for both pleasure anglers and specimen hunters alike at a very competitive cost. Membership is limited to 120 persons to preserve the tranquil nature of our waters which are all situated within an 8 mile radius of Framlingham.

Subscription details are available on request from the Membership Secretary (see below). General meetings, to which all members are welcome, are held on the third Thursday of each month at the notified venue, commencing at 8pm.

OUTLINE OF CURRENT CLUB WATERS.

HAYWARDS, situated in Wickham Market.

Two reservoirs, each of about 1 acre, holding Bream, Tench, Roach, Rudd, and Pike. Easy access from the A12 and B1078, with car parking on site.

YOUNGMANS, situated near Charsfield.

Two reservoirs of about 1 and 2 acres respectively, both in secluded locations. The smaller fishery holds Carp, Roach, Rudd, Perch and Tench. At approximately half a mile distant, the larger fishery holds Bream, Carp, Roach, Rudd, Perch and Tench.

LARTERS, situated close to Framlingham.

Set in an out of the way location, this attractive water of around three quarters of an acre contains Carp, Rudd, Bream and Tench.

RIVER DEBEN, Campsea Ashe.

Around half a mile along one bank, with Roach, Chub, Perch, Pike and a few Bream.

CAMPSEA ASHE RESERVOIR.

An attractive water of around 2/3rds of an acre, containing Carp, Roach, Rudd, Perch, Bream, Tench and Pike.
